

CONDITIONS OF SALE

Artwork: Proceeds from the sale of artwork during the Art Auction for Student Scholarship will go to raise scholarship dollars for Latino and other minority students studying at Rutgers, the State University of New Jersey.

Artwork can be viewed online at clac.rutgers.edu or viewed in person by appointment at the Center for Latino Arts and Culture, 122 College Avenue, New Brunswick NJ 08901. Actual colors of the artwork viewed online may vary slightly from their originals due to differences in monitor settings and the limitations of digital photography. Bids: Bids are made by submitting this form by fax or mail, or by contacting CLAC director Carlos Fernandez at 732-932-1263 and providing the information requested on this form. The deadline for bids is March 31, 2008 at 5:00 pm.

When you bid on a work of art, you decide for yourself how much you would like to pay for it. If you have a valid winning bid at the close of the auction and your credit card is authorized for full payment by your bank, you will win the work of art. Once a bid has been submitted you may not cancel it. Your card will not be charged when you submit a bid. Your card will be charged only if you have a valid winning bid at the close of the auction. The price you pay for the artwork will be the actual amount you bid. The winning bid will not be determined until all auction bids, if any, have been received on March 31, 2008. The auctioneer will acknowledge your bid and knock down the work to you at the most favorable price, taking into consideration other bids. Winning bidders will be notified by April 15, 2007.

Payment: Payment for the art work will be accepted via credit card (VISA, MasterCard or AMEX). CLAC Director Carlos Fernandez will be contacting the winning bidders at the e-mail addresses or phone numbers provided on the bidder registration.

IRS states that persons who purchase items at a charity auction may claim a charitable contribution deduction for the excess of the purchased price paid for an item over its fair market value. The RU Foundation will forward donors official receipts for tax deductible donations through the mail.

Shipment: Winning bidders are encouraged to pick-up the artwork in person at the Center for Latino Arts and Culture, 122 College Avenue, New Brunswick, NJ 08901, as we cannot guarantee the condition of the packaged artwork should it be handled by a delivery service. All shipping costs, if necessary, are the responsibility of the bidder and will be charged to their credit card. Items will only be shipped through UPS and their specialty packaging services. All artwork will be packaged for fragile shipping and insured, with those costs being the responsibility of the winning bidder requesting shipping.

Return Policy: Auction items are non-refundable.
