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CLAC Student Activities Allocation Program Guidelines

The Center for Latino Arts and Culture was established in 1992 to advance, research and document arts and humanities scholarship, artistic production and cultural traditions of Latinos n the United States, the Caribbean and the Americas. The Center sees the arts and culture as the impetus for educational change, bridging communities and improving the quality of life for students, faculty and the community at large.

In order to apply for funding, please complete the entire application. Incomplete applications will <u>not</u> be considered. The Center has discretion as to whether or not to fund a project/program regardless of whether it meets the criteria set forth in these guidelines. The criteria for funding are:

- ♦ Event must create bridges across two or more culturally diverse groups through planning and/or outreach
- ♦ Event must enhance awareness of Latino arts and culture among the Rutgers community
- Event must demonstrate sound planning in terms of program budget, logistics, promotion, and evaluation

Other factors that the Center will consider in making its decision are your organization's mission, purpose, and record of previous funding from CLAC. Depending on the scope of the program and how well it matches our funding criteria, the Center will fund up to 35% of total program expenses. However, CLAC funding <u>must</u> be matched from other sources. Eligible expenses are speaker and artist fees, travel, marketing and promotion, and production fees. Wages of labor are not eligible for funding.
